

## **Webinar: Fraud Awareness Briefing**

**Description:** In effort to increase fraud awareness, the U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI) Office of Inspector General (OIG) coordinates and conducts Fraud Awareness Briefings (FAB). On Thursday, July 23, 2015, DOI OIG Investigative Analyst, Vicki Josupait, will conduct a one-hour FAB that is designed to educate Bureau of Indian Education personnel, contractors and recipients about various fraud schemes and indicators, as well as the need for strong internal controls to help them to prevent and detect fraud. In this webinar, the FAB will discuss real case examples, and how and where to report wrong-doing that is suspected.

**Presenter bio:** Vicki Josupait is an Investigative Analyst for the DOI OIG in Lakewood, Colorado. She received her Master of Science in Criminal Justice from the University of Colorado at Denver and also holds degrees in Recreation Administration, Natural Resource Recreation Management, and Marketing.
