The BIE Organization: Inspiring the Next Generation

Description

Over the past two years, the BIE has worked with a significant number of tribes, schools, and stakeholders to redesign its organizational structure to meet the shifting demands of its school system. The changing culture of schools demands a new BIE that meets the needs of the 64 tribal communities that have BIE-funded schools. The BIE will conduct a webinar on Friday, October 2, 2015 to provide an update on the reorganization. During this one-hour webinar, BIE Director, Dr. Charles Roessel, will discuss the BIE's future and provide updates on its reorganization based on input from tribal consultations.

About the Presenter



Dr. Charles "Monty" Roessel is an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation. He has served as the Director of the Bureau of Indian Education since 2013, overseeing 183 schools located on 64 tribal communities and 23 states. Currently, Dr. Roessel is undertaking a major reform effort of the BIE to create a school improvement agency. He also serves as a member of the American Indian Education Study group, established by both Interior Secretary Sally Jewell and Education Secretary Arne Duncan.
