Dear Tribal Leader:

The Bureau of Indian Education ("BIE") is responsible for ensuring that its implementation of Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA")<sup>1</sup> is consistent with federal law including requirements at 20 U.S.C. §§ 1411(h)(2)(A) and 1412(a) and 34 C.F.R. § 300.708(a). Accordingly, BIE is proposing to update its IDEA policies and procedures that apply to BIE-funded schools.

The proposed policies cover ten topic areas as summarized below:

- 1. Parental Consent, Involvement and Procedural Safeguards
- 2. Referral and Determination of Eligibility
- 3. Individual Education Program, IEP Development and Least Restrictive Environment
- 4. Dispute Resolution
- 5. Child Find
- 6. Early Intervening Services
- 7. Discipline
- 8. Transition Services
- 9. Exiting Special Education
- 10. Confidentiality
