<u>Purpose and Focus of the BIE Standards Assessments and Accountability System</u> <u>Rulemaking Committee (from the Committee charter)</u>

Advise the Secretary of the Interior (Secretary) through the Bureau of Indian Education (BIE) and the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on the development of proposed regulations that:

- Fulfill the Secretary's responsibility to define standards, assessments, and accountability system for schools funded by the BIE
- Are consistent with ESEA section 1111
- Taking into account the unique circumstances and needs of such schools and the students served by such schools on a national, regional, or tribal basis, as appropriate
- And the process for requesting a waiver of these definitions and technical assistance
- Recommendations will focus on the regulations at 25 C.F.R. Part 30, *Adequate Yearly Progress*.

Draft and submit a report containing a proposal, or a report on any areas on which consensus is reached. The report may include any other information, recommendations, or materials that the Committee considers appropriate.
