The Bureau of Indian Education’s (BIE) Chief Academic Office (CAO) is pleased to provide information regarding the BIE-Unified Standards, Assessments, and Accountability System (SAAS) for BIE-funded schools for School Year (SY) 2024-2025. BIE’s SAAS is in accordance with BIE regulations at 25 C.F.R. Part 30 and outlined and published in the BIE Agency Plan approved by the U.S. Department of Education.

All BIE-funded schools are required to administer the BIE-Unified assessments unless both BIE and the U.S. Department of Education (ED) have granted a waiver for SY 2024-2025 in accordance with 25 C.F.R. Part 30. All waiver submissions to the BIE will be for SY 2024-2025 and on. The SY 2024-2025 Assessment Testing Windows are as follows and are subject to change:

- English Language Proficiency, January 13 – February 13, 2025
- Alternate (ELA/Math/Science), March 10 – April 25, 2025
- ELA/Math, March 17 – April 25, 2025
- Science, March 10 – April 18, 2025
